1885: The Statue of Liberty arrives in New York Harbor as a gift of friendship from France. The landmark was shipped across the Atlantic in 350 pieces.

1894: Congress establishes Labor Day as a federal holiday.

1922: The American Library Association awards the first Newbery Medal, which honors children's literature, to "The Story of Mankind" by Hendrik Willem van Loon.

1933: The first drive-in movie theater opens in Camden, N.J.

1934: Disney character Donald Duck makes his screen debut in the cartoon "The Wise Little Hen."

1939: Dedicated to preserving America's favorite pastime, the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum opens in Cooperstown, N.Y.

1953: Queen Elizabeth II is formally crowned monarch of the United Kingdom at a lavish coronation ceremony in London's Westminster Abbey.

1974: The Universal Product Code, better known as a bar code, is used for

the first time, allowing electronic price scanning of consumer products.

1980: CNN, the first 24-hour TV news network, makes its first broadcast.

1983: With the launch of the space shuttle Challenger, Sally Ride becomes the first American woman to travel into space. At age 32, she was also the youngest astronaut in space.

1997: The first book in the Harry Potter series, "Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone," is published in the U.K. The title of the later American edition was changed to "Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone."
